Days and times of the various lessons are available during registration day and on the website. **Brian Draxl**, Head Pro or **Shane Hickson**, Pro will help determine which lesson groups would be best for you at time of registration. You must register in person on registration day **March 24th**. Registration in lessons is first come, first served. Limited spaces available. Adult lessons are \$80.00 per session and Junior lessons are \$65.00 per session.

MINI TENNIS LESSONS

Tennis lessons for children aged 4 to 7 years old (membership is not required). These lessons are designed specifically for the little people new to tennis. They will be using lightweight junior racquets and mini nets. The emphasis is on learning with a smile, building self-esteem and developing co-ordination skills. A fun way to learn the beginning skills of tennis! Mini tennis lessons are \$45.00 for an 8 week session.

For intermediate and advanced players interested in competitive tennis with other clubs in and around York Region, we have several levels of InterCounty play.
